
Education has always been a corner stone of society, the pillar on which the bulwark of human existence rests, the leading light as mankind made its way in the quest of the unknown.




the facility - Aashiana Branch

Situated amidst a brilliantly planned and a very green colony, Aashiana in Lucknow, the school has a huge 2 acres of campus with a seating capacity of more than 2000 students and is approximately 10 minutes away from the Airport and 15 minutes from Lucknow Railway Station.

The negligible pollution levels and the ever flowing positive energy in and around the campus fills one with confidence and boosts up their morale to do greater things in life.

A building with over 50 classrooms has separate blocks for various disciplines of science, music, art & craft. The school has a completely self-contained campus comprising of everything that students on campus would ever require. Be it state-of-the-art equipment used for regular teaching & projects or air-conditioned classrooms or well equipped laboratories & library, the school has it all.





Dhawapur Branch

The branch is situated in Dhawapur on Kanpur – Mohanlalganj by-pass. It is at a mere 15 minutes drive from the Lucknow Airport. The campus is huge with a total area of 4 acres and a seating capacity of 3500 students.

It is located in an extremely green locale with almost negligible pollution and uses maximum natural lights. The campus also has a complete system for “Rain Water Harvesting”.

SCIENCE LABORATORIES

Both campuses of Vishwanath Academy have fully-equipped and brightly lit Science Laboratories that help experimentation and develop scientific temper among students. There are separate sections for Biology, Physics and Chemistry with equipment and specimens to meet the needs of young learners.

EXCELLENCE IN USE OF DIGITAL TECHNOLOGY

Digital learning is a practice of effectively using technology to strengthen a student's learning experience. It emphasises high-quality instructions and provides access to challenging content, feedback through formative assessment, and individualised instructions to ensure all students can reach their full potential.

Increasing equity and access to high-quality digital learning technology has improved the effectiveness & productivity of teachers. But we at Vishwanath Academy believe that technology can never completely replace a teacher, thus, here both go hand in hand.

SMART CLASSES

Besides traditional way of teaching, our schools are well equipped with smart classes. E-learning or smart class helps to remember something that is taught visually rather than the one that is read through pages after pages.

Smart classes use all interactive modules like videos & presentations. This kind of visual is both eye-catching and young students can easily relate with it.

COMPUTER LABORATORIES

Both branches of the school have sophisticated Computer laboratories where students of all classes are exposed to the computer aided learning. In each of our labs, we have around 75 personal computers apart from the various multimedia kits, laser and ink-jet printers, scanners, over-head projectors, broad band internet connectivity, etc. We have regular teachers for teaching computer science along with lab assistants.

It is mandatory for all classes to visit computer labs and practice their lessons to have a much better understanding and to develop their skills in using computers.

Apart from teaching computer science the schools use a lot of technology.

- **State-of-the-art ERP software** (Quick-School) to assist in school management programmes.
- Our computer networking system enables us to communicate important messages to parents via the SMS server.
- We also have a **biometric system of attendance** for the teachers.
- Most of our teaching staff and the admin team is also well trained in usage of computers.




This aspiration makes education a challenging process and takes it beyond imparting text book knowledge. It means developing a sensitive attitude, empathy and rational thinking.

- Photocopy of Birth Certificate [attested]
- Photocopy of the result of the previous class [attested]
- Address Proof: Aadhaar Card (of the child)/Pan Card/Driving Licence /Electricity Bill of parents
- Transfer Certificate (TC) from the previous school

Note: Incomplete or illegible Registration forms, without photos will not be accepted.

ADMISSION TEST

- A basic admission test will be conducted on specified date for eligibility of that particular class.

- Only those candidates who clear the written test will be called for an interview, both parents are required to be present at the time of the interview.
- The admission would be confirmed only after the final interview.

MID-TERM ADMISSION

Only meritorious students will be considered for mid-term admission on grounds of transfer or change of school.

The school reserves the right to admit a student in the appropriate class after examining the student. Even after the admission is granted the student can either be adjusted in lower or higher class, which ever the case may be, depending upon the student's ability at the discretion of the authorities.

TRANSFER CERTIFICATE
